This presentation is designed to assist law enforcement professionals in developing strategies to avoid the loss of idealism and inappropriate behavior patterns. It will review the effects on officers on both the personal and professional aspects of their lives. The course will discuss how the initial enthusiasm and desire to professionally contribute can be transformed into negative cynicism, social distrust and hostility to the world at large that significantly impact work performance, decision-making, and, ultimately, overall quality of life. The course will review the impact on children of law enforcement families in terms of school functioning and health.

The goal of the course is to have the LEO review the impact the career causes in the personal life and develop strategies for overall emotional survival. This course is presented at all FBI LEEDS and Executive Development Institutes at the FBI Academy in Quantico.

Kevin Gilmartin's book, "Emotional Survival for Law Enforcement," was written to encourage officers to take charge of their lives in order to physically and emotionally survive a career in law enforcement and to overcome the internal assaults they experience personally and professionally. These assaults can turn a positive, enthusiastic officer into an angry, cynical individual. "It is not good enough to hire good people; organizations and individuals must do what they can to keep good people good."
